News from the Undergraduates

Dear Alumni Brothers:

The 2012-2013 year at the Lodge has been an eventful and productive one. This fall we successfully initiated 24 new members into the Omi Deut charge. The members of the class of 2015 are lacrosse players, rowers, a Marine Corps veteran, and even a Classics major. These guys have fully embraced active roles at the Lodge and are excited for the opportunity to live at the Lodge for the sophomore summer glory days.

During the winter term we actively participated in charitable efforts on campus. In January we helped co-sponsor the Rose Benefit for Autism Speaks. The Theta Delta Chi national philanthropy effort is Autism Speaks, an autism science and advocacy organization dedicated to funding research into the causes,

prevention, treatments and a cure for autism; increasing awareness of autism spectrum disorders; and advocating for the needs of individuals with autism and their families. We also co-sponsored the campus-wide event Country For a Cause, a country music concert held at Alumni Hall. The proceeds went to David's House, a support facility and a home-away-from-home for families with children receiving medical care at the Children's Hospital at Dartmouth. Now that spring is here we have shifted our focus to The Prouty fundraiser this summer. The Prouty is a charitable fundraiser for cancer research and services at the Norris Cotton Cancer Center at Dartmouth. We've been the top fundraisers at Dartmouth in the past few years, raising nearly \$100,000 in two summers. Finally, we should share several individual accomplishments. Senior Conor Reilly set the 60m school record at 6.75 and was IC4A champion in the 60m this year in indoor Track and Field. Conor also set the 100m school record at 10.46 last year. In football, Senior Ted Reed was named Second Team All-Ivy after a stellar season on the gridiron. Our very own Garrett Wymore, senior linebacker and rugby enthusiast, was named a finalist for the prestigious Rhodes Scholarship for his efforts in the classroom. We also have several sports team captains at the Lodge. Xander Centenari '13 and Mike Jacobs '13 were both named captains of the Tennis team. Bronson Green '14 was named captain of the football team and will again serve as captain for the 2013 season. Chris Costabile '13, Nikki Dysenchuk '13, Pat Flynn '13, and Pat Resch '14 currently serve as captains of the Lacrosse team.

The Lodge looks prime and ready for a beautiful Hanover spring; the Boys sure are. We hope to see some of you here in the next few weeks to enjoy it with us!
