## Philanthropy

The undergrads have been making impactful philanthropic efforts, completing over 500 hours of community service over the past year across the Upper Valley. In addition to their local efforts, a few of the brothers took a trip to Nicaragua, raising \$10,895 to fund the construction of a home for a Nicaraguan family and sports equipment for the children of the town that they worked in. In the spring, the brothers held the pig roast to benefit Autism Speaks, raising close to \$1,000, charging an entrance fee and selling tee shirts to commemorate the event. Over the summer, the house participated in the annual Prouty bike ride (page 3) and organized a golf tournament, the Summer Salute, to benefit the Semper Fi Fund, which helps wounded Marines upon their return to their homes; The event was a success, raising over \$5,000 for the cause. The brothers held the summer pig roast to benefit WISE, an organization that provides advocacy, crisis services, and community education to those affected by domestic and sexual violence and stalking throughout the Upper Valley, and raised nearly \$1,000.
